Dear Parents:

Central District Health Department (CDHD) will be providing an immunization record Assessment and administering Tdap and Meningococcal vaccine at the August 11, 2011 high school sports physicals being held at Mountain Home High School from 3-8pm. Your child’s vaccination status will not impact their eligibility to play sports. This is an opportunity to vaccinate your child and remind parents of other recommended adolescent vaccines.

Please send your child’s immunizations records with them to the school physical event!

What should your student expect?

CDHD staff will assess your child’s records (based solely on the records provided to us during the physicals). A completed immunization review form and vaccine educational materials will be sent home with your child.

What should parents do?

If you would like your child to receive a Tdap and/or Meningococcal vaccine, please follow these steps:

- a) Fill out the **Immunization Consent and Immunization Screening Forms** and return with your student the day of the sport physicals. A copy of the forms can be found online at www.cdhd.idaho.gov
- b) **ALL** questions **MUST** be answered; CDHD will not vaccinate students with incomplete paperwork
- c) **SIGN AND DATE** the consent form
- d) **RETURN** the completed Vaccination Consent Form and a copy of your insurance card with your child to the sports physical clinic on August 11.
- e) **DO NOT** return the Consent Form if you **do not** wish your child to be vaccinated at the clinic.

What is my cost? There is no cost for the vaccine; however, there is an administration fee. CDHD will bill your Insurance/Medicaid for the administration fee(s). If you do not have insurance, we will bill you directly at a cost of **\$14.34** per vaccine. No one will be denied vaccination due to inability to pay.
