

# VOTE ABSENTEE

Request a ballot and vote absentee to help keep your community safe. Your ballot will be mailed directly to your home and can be returned by mail.

## REGISTER TO VOTE & REQUEST A BALLOT

Visit [IdahoVotes.gov](https://IdahoVotes.gov) to register to vote and request a ballot online. To request a ballot for the August or November Elections, please submit your request by 5 p.m. on Friday, August 14th.




## WAIT FOR YOUR BALLOT

Give our team some time to process your request. It may take up to 10 days for you to receive a ballot.

## VOTE & RETURN YOUR BALLOT

As soon as you receive your ballot, use the pre-addressed, postage paid envelope to mail it back to us. Remember to sign your envelope. All ballots must be received (not postmarked) by 8 p.m. on Election Day.



## WHY VOTE ABSENTEE?

Voting absentee is a safe and convenient option that many Idahoans rely on each election. Voting by mail is a means to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus, which protects your neighbors and community, while ensuring that your vote counts.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO VOTE ABSENTEE?

You must be registered to vote at your current address and submit a request to have a ballot mailed to you. Simply visit [idahovotes.gov](http://idahovotes.gov) to register and request a ballot online.

## IS ABSENTEE VOTING SECURE?

Yes, in fact, absentee voting is the primary way that U.S. citizens overseas and military personnel and their families vote. Ada County Elections has numerous measures in place to ensure your ballot is secure, including signature verification on each returned mail ballot.
