

What to Know About Hepatitis A

How is it Spread?



Not washing hands



Sexual contact with an infected person



Eating/drinking contaminated food



Recreational Drug Use

Hepatitis A can also be spread through close contact with someone infected with hepatitis A.

What are the Symptoms?



Yellowing of skin and eyes (jaundice)



Fever



Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

Symptoms may also include: dark pee, pale poop, stomach pain, tiredness, lack of appetite. If you have symptoms please call your healthcare provider or local health department.

Prevention



Get vaccinated for hepatitis A



Wash your hands with soap & water after using the bathroom, before eating & before preparing food

WHO SHOULD GET VACCINATED?

- People who use recreational drugs
- Men who have sex with men
- People who are homeless or in transient living
- People who have direct contact with someone with hepatitis A
