### Who Can Receive Care?

Available to Ada, Boise, Canyon, Elmore, Gem, and Valley County families or households, with:

- Pregnant women, infant or child(ren) through age 5
- History of neglect, abuse, parent or household member with mental illness or substance use, low-birth weight, teen pregnancy
- Life events that impact children (divorce, violence, trauma)
- Medicaid recipients; some non-Medicaid receiving individuals/households may also qualify for covered care

### About Our Services

Our In-Home Mental Health Services offer individualized programs for pregnant women, infants and children through age five, to help guide healthy relationships, emotions, and behaviors.

Visits are provided in your home by a licensed therapist and encourage the participation of family and household members.
